REGISTRATION

- Registration of artwork is Monday, August 27, 6-8 pm and Tuesday, August 28, 11 am- 2 pm.
- Pickup of unaccepted artwork Thursday, August 30, 5-8 pm.
- Artwork pickup after exhibition closing Sunday, October 14, 1-3 pm
* No artwork may be picked up before the close of the show.
- Artists may select a preference between exhibiting at the DSA Gallery or at the Front Street Buildings satellite gallery or both. The DSA Board and Staff will determine location based on preference and availability.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

- Membership is a requirement to participate. Each Member is guaranteed 1 piece in the exhibition. Artists may enter up to 3 pieces in any medium.
- There is a non-refundable fee of \$12 per piece. All fees go to the ADA Fundraising Project and exhibition costs.
- Deliver artwork, with labels attached, to the 48 High Street Gallery during registration at the times listed above.
- Cash, check and credit card payments are accepted. Make checks payable to the Dayton Society of Artists.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR ARTWORK

- Work previous shown in a DSA juried show is not eligible.
- All artwork must be professionally presented.
- Framed work must be wired on the back to be used with the DSA hanging system. Sawtooth hangers are NOT acceptable. Work under 15 lbs. can be hung with 3M Velcro Strips. Strips are attached to artwork or frames directly. Unframed works on paper may be hung with Bull Clips.
- Work cannot exceed 20 h. x 20 inches or 20 h. x 20 x 20 inches in any direction, including framing.

LIABILITY & SALES

- The DSA does not insure work in transit to or from the gallery. Artists maintain responsibility of insuring the work during shipping and travel.
- The DSA has Fine Art Coverage Insurance on site at the gallery. Insurance price over \$500 then any insurance claims must be accompanied by documentation of past sales and or professional 3rd party appraisals.
- Artists are responsible to insure their own work at the Front Street Buildings satellite gallery space.
- DSA requires NO COMMISSION on sales during the Members Exhibition but appreciates donations that support future programming.
- Gallery hours are covered by the DSA staff.
